#### Dear RMS-CES Families,

We have had a great week at RMS-CES with so many fun memories. A few of my favorites include welcoming 6th graders who came back from Deep Portage with big smiles on their faces, getting a chance to talk to all the fifth graders, and meeting with our student council for the first time. Below are a few updates.

<u>Deep Portage</u>: Since our sixth graders returned from Deep Portage Wednesday afternoon, I have heard nothing but amazing things about their experience during their 3-day stay at Deep Portage. Staff and chaperones were incredibly complimentary of students while they were up there. I'm grateful. Not only that our students had such a positive experience, but they also represented the Rockford area community incredibly well with their engagement, cleanliness, and desire to learn.

<u>Conferences</u>: I just wanted to have you save the date that RMS-CES middle school conferences will happen on October 17th from 3:30 to 7:30. Attending conferences is optional to parents, and is traditionally thought of as a time to connect regarding your progress or any concerns. More information will follow in the coming days.

<u>Arriving to class on Time</u>: The habits that students create during the middle school years serve them well throughout their course of high school and beyond. One habit were really trying to help students understand is the value of making sure you're showing up to class on time. The vast majority of our students do an incredible job with this, but I want to make sure all parents know that our school will continually focus on helping students get to class on time and in the coming days and weeks. Please know that if your child has five or more Tardy marks you will receive a letter from me via email in the near future.

Secure Mode Drill: Please know that on Wednesday, October 4th at approximately 8:50 am. we will have a Secure Mode Drill which is a part of our Safety and Security Process. Secure mode is used if we were to have a threat outside of the building or an indirect threat/situation such as a medical emergency. Our process is quite simple as we will have about 5 minutes where we will not allow visitors in the building, and keep students in their classroom as normal.

<u>Bus Evacuation Drill:</u> On Thursday, October 5th during boost, students will go out to some buses that will be on site and review transportation expectations with the drivers and participate in a mandatory bus evacuation drill. This should take no more than 15 mintues.
