
In the Classroom

- The office also has some copies of the book if you are interested in doing your own read aloud.




I'm not scared! I'm prepared!





says we need to LOCK DOWN


says INFORM, 'cause we must tell others if we've seen the wolf around.

stands for EVACUATE, which means leave the building and run away!"


"But where do we run? I asked, and when do we stop?"

Just get to where you're supposed to be."


"I am your shepherd, and you are my sheep, and you need to do what I say.


There's a wolf in the building...a dangerous someone, and we need to stay out of his way!"


"If we need to go into LOCK DOWN, we get quiet and stay out of sight. But we don't try to hide in the closet, or squish together too close and tight."


"We need to be ready to move and spread out, so don't all stand in a clump. Have enough space to move your arms in a circle, and get your legs ready to JUMP!"




































Then, we ran outside and kept running as fast as we could until we got to the great big, huge tree. And then we stopped.
