

Bilton School – Homework in **Geography**

Vision

- The fundamental vision is that all homework set should **support learning** and **enhance** the curriculum experience for the child.
- Homework will either be **consolidatory** (cementing learning) or **exploratory** (opportunities for curiosity). A baseline recommendation is 80:20 (Consolidatory:Exploratory), but different departments will want to change ratios at different times of the year to match sequencing of lessons during class time.

Post 16	<p>Student will be set work by both teachers to consolidate and pre learn through wider reading using academic article such as geofiles. As well as the core textbook, online learning platforms such as Seneca learning will be used. it is the expectation that students should be producing revision material each week based upon their lesson content to prepare for the exam. Students will need to work on their NEA coursework during the 2year course.</p>
