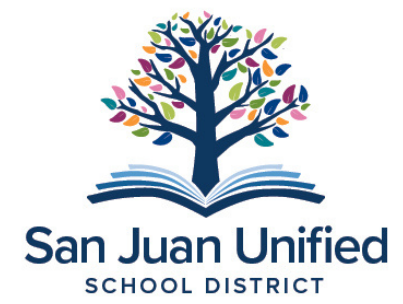

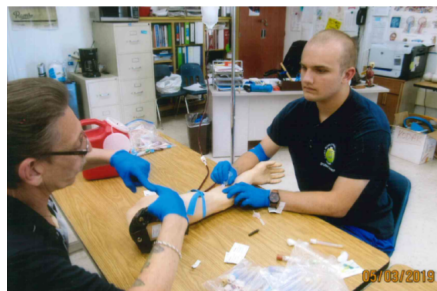

Health Academy

The SCORE Health Academy pathway is for students who are interested in fields such as medical assistants, EMT, nursing, physician assistants, physicians, x-ray tech, athletic training, physical therapist assistant, physical therapy, kinesiology, nutrition, and other medical related fields. Students will have hands-on-training, such as taking blood pressure, rooming patients, assisting with minor surgery, and/or front office duties. In their senior year, students will be placed in the medical field for on-the-job experience.



Equipment & Training

Students are placed in the field to learn hands on skills using:

- Syringes
- Blood pressure monitors
- Patient vital-sign monitoring devices and carts
- Thermometers
- Electrocardiography machines
- Flu and Strep Tests
- Diabetic Tests
