7:23 Administrative Report (Kate Arch). Related Powerpoints sent before meeting.

- Tardy challenge: no more than six tardies in order to attend social on September 22. Fewer than 20 kids have exceeded this amount.
- Teachers Mr. Anderson and Ms. Hazelwood will spearhead the fun run on November 3.
- New math curriculum is being rolled out (thank you, math teachers!)

- Ms. Arch will continue to send a weekly bulletin to parents.

School Improvement Plan updates (PowerPoint)

- Literacy: Focus on all the contents found in ELA. Goal achievable, if a stretch.
- Numeracy: looking good, should meet or exceed goal
- MLL (multilingual learners) numbers. The progress of students in ELD (English Language Development) is measured, but not those who have been moved up to Monitoring status. There are 30-40 students in this group at Clayton.
- Culture goal: 9 or fewer absences for each student during the school year

LAND Trust update: Reading Teacher (2022-23)

- Last year, Clayton went from 50 to 55% students in the proficient, or blue, lexile band (indicates grade-level proficiency).
- Dr. Rodgers (ELD Coach) will be coming in for 3 sessions.

7:38 LAND Trust Plan for 2023-24 (Adrian Bancroft)

- Continue to support Reading Teacher.
- District has shifted to different test for measuring literacy.
 - Focus on kids reading below grade level. "Basic" range or higher indicates the student is achieving or nearly achieving on grade level.
- Bancroft will send out the document with updated details.

7:40 School Counselor Report (Anena Gardner)

- Gina Williams will usually be at SCC meetings. Anena is here today.
- Two small groups starting:
 - Voices (Volunteers of America)
 - Social Skills (starting September)
- Counselors are currently following up on referrals for counseling services, sending out permission slips, and contacting parents.
- School-wide Weekly Advisory on Wednesdays (Mr. Guido in charge this year): current focus is G19 anti-harassment and bullying.
 - G19 trainings need to be reviewed, not approved, by this group.
