
## **Business Academy**

In the Business Entrepreneurship Academy students will think and act in a creative manner, obtain exposure to local small business owners, assess their potential for entrepreneurial careers and develop skills that will be useful in any future academic and/or professional endeavor. Students will learn about traditional entrepreneurial sectors utilizing marketing, finance, production, public relations, and human resources. Personal finance, team building, leadership, post-secondary goals, and business ethics are emphasized as well as mentoring. In the capstone course, students attend class daily for two weeks; then are placed into Community internships four days a week at local businesses.
