### SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS

Established in 1934, Laguna Beach High School (LBHS) has an enrollment of 885 students, is the only high school within the Laguna Beach Unified School District, and is the smallest public high school in Orange County. LBHS offers a strong college-preparatory program and was named a California Gold Ribbon School in 2016 and 2017 and a California Distinguished School in 2012. In 2019, LBHS received a six-year accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

### GRADING & CLASS RANKING

To address the educational needs of students affected by the Covid-19 crisis, the Board of Trustees approved three grading terms for courses for the 2020-2021 school year: trimesters (10 credits), semesters (5 credits), and yearlong (10 credits). Students received letter grades at the end of each course term. In 2021-2022, the school year was divided into two semesters. Students received letter grades each semester and two progress reports during the course of the semester. This will remain the same for the 2023-2024 school year.

The Academic Grade Point Average (GPA) and class rank are based on all grades with the exception of physical education and athletics. Advanced Placement and some honors courses receive an extra point in calculating the GPA.

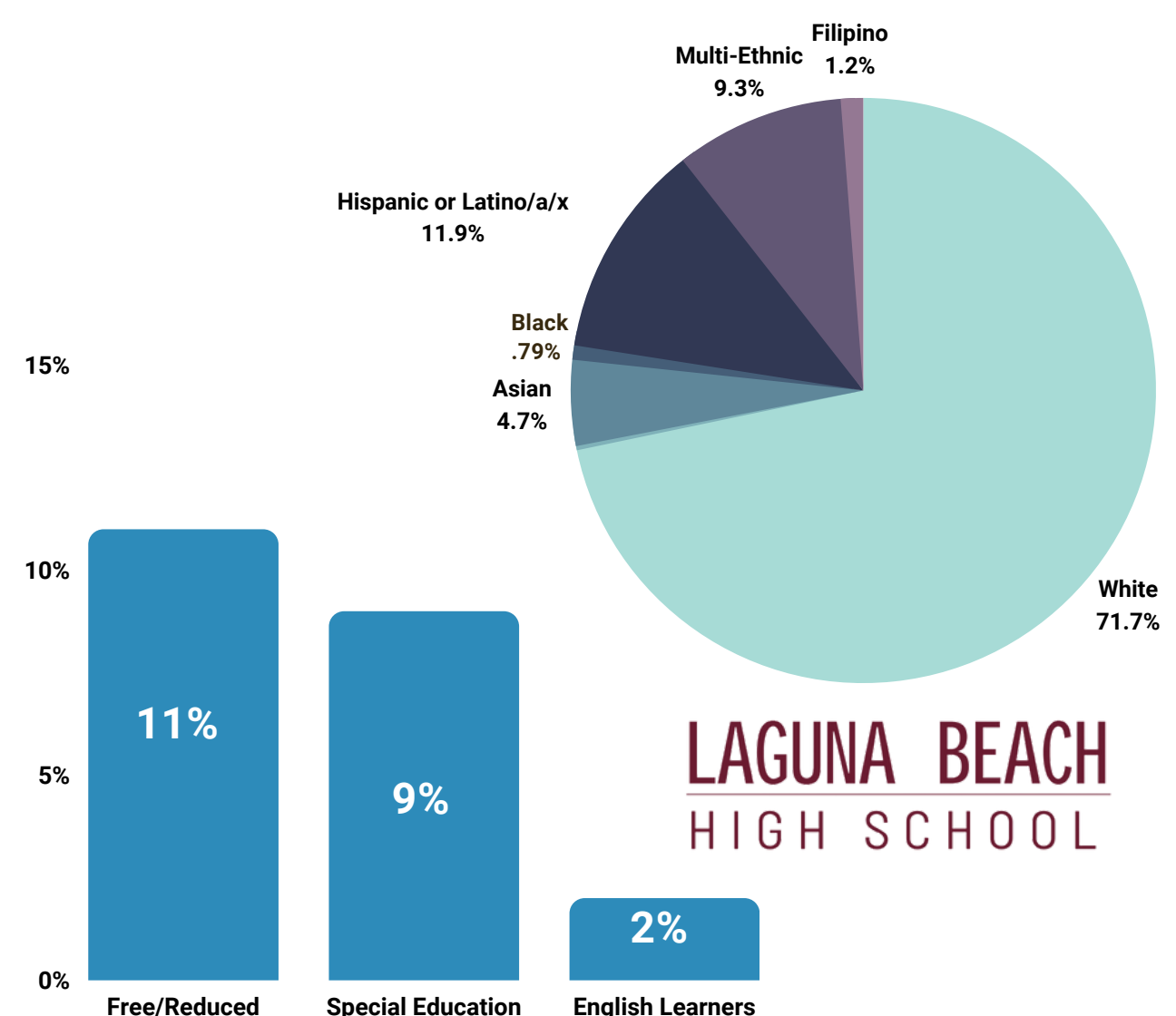
### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

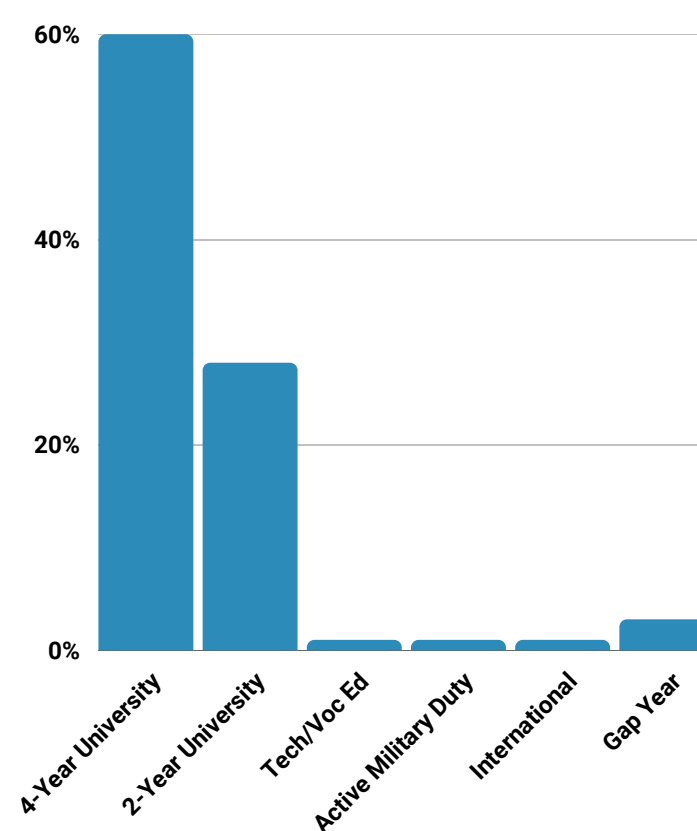
