- C. Golf coaches will be paid a maximum of two (2) weeks of post season pay. One week for the Spring Qualifier, and one week for the State Tournament.
- D. Tennis Coaches that coach both genders will be paid a maximum of three weeks of post season pay. One week in the fall (Boys' Districts) and two weeks in the spring (Girls' Districts, Boys' and Girls' State).
- **E.** A coach will be paid .5 of the post-season stipend if the program is eliminated on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday of a post season week. The full post-season stipend will be earned and paid for weeks where the program competes past Wednesday.
