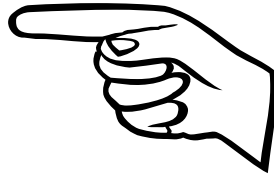
Last week we started NWEA Testing and your students rocked it!!!!!!!!!!

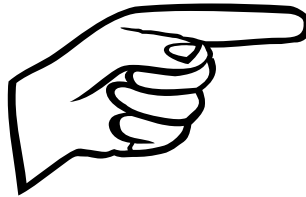
Meet Our Kindergarten Staff

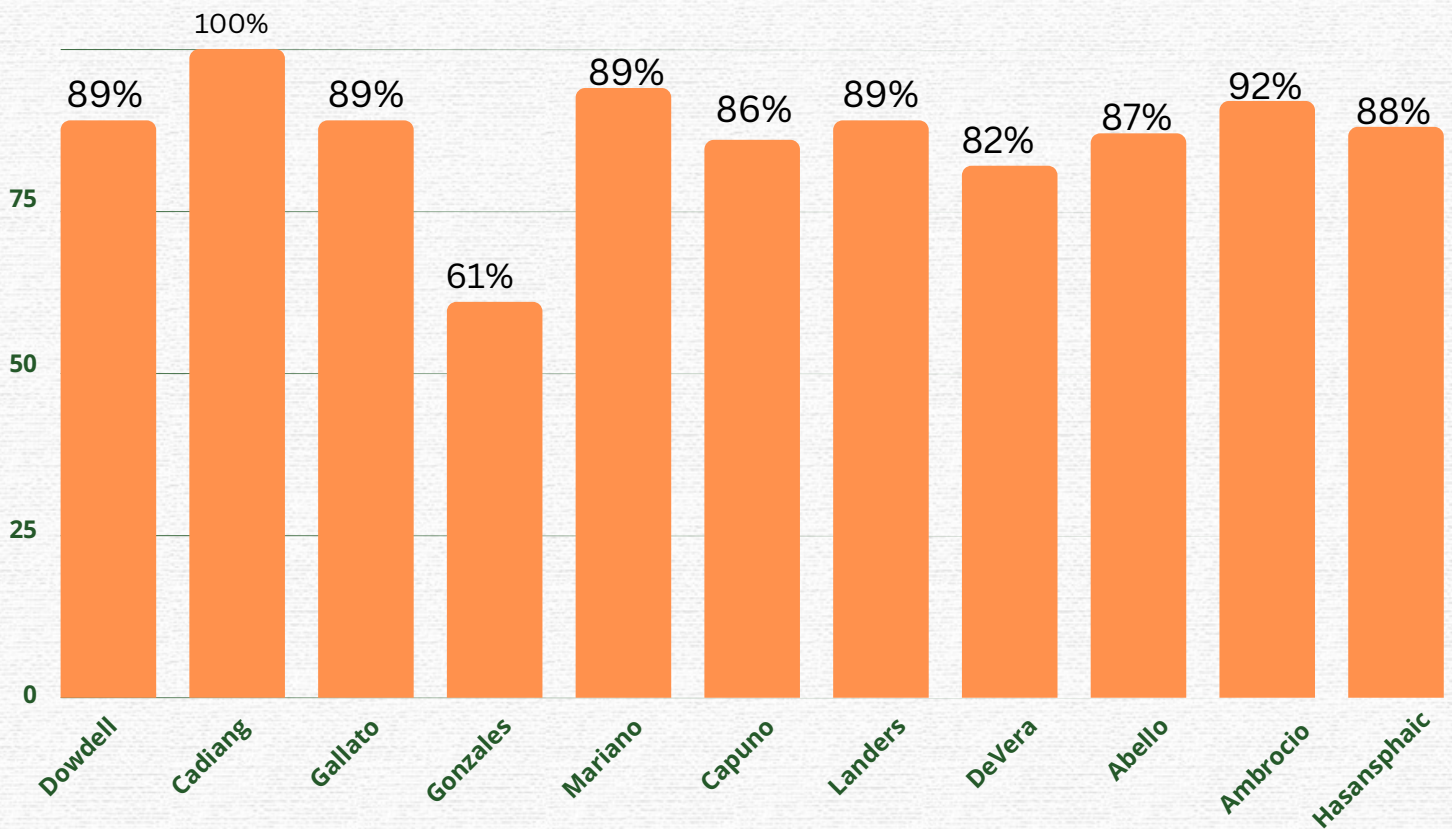
