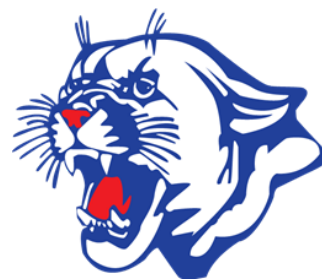

WEF College Fair, October 5th, 2023

The Wisconsin Education Fair (WEF) is coming to Janesville Craig High School on Thursday October 5th from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM in the Craig High School Fieldhouse.

ALL Craig High Juniors and Seniors need to register in advance for this event. The Fair will provide an excellent opportunity to obtain information about the programs of approximately 75 different post-secondary schools featuring all Wisconsin Universities and many more from around the Midwest.

Juniors- this is your time to begin thinking about post high school education and options.

Seniors- big opportunity to visit with schools or add more to your radar to apply to.

All Craig Seniors will be released from class to visit the WEF from 9:00am-9:45am

All Craig Juniors will be released from class to visit the WEF from 10:10am-11:00am

Representatives from the various universities, colleges, technical and vocational colleges, trade schools and the military will be present to talk about a variety of educational opportunities.

No formal presentations will be held. Students will be free to move around the fieldhouse, spending as much time as they wish with the individual representatives to gather information on colleges and post-secondary options they would like to learn more about.

Students attending the event MUST be pre-registered and have an assigned barcode that allows college representatives to quickly scan and obtain the student's information (name/ address/ phone #/ email) to send more materials from the colleges to them.

The barcode will be texted to the student phone which can be shared with the college representatives. Use the QR code below to register (this will take 5 minutes at most.) You can skip GPA and test scores as they are optional.
