Community Service

Physics First Curriculum

All freshmen take Physics. The Physics First Program was developed in 2003 in coordination with Project ARISE with the goal of integrating the learning of science and math to develop confidence and passion to pursue careers in STEM fields. After completion, students continue to follow the PCB science sequence – Physics, Chemistry, Biology.

Advanced Placement Offerings

Enrollment is competitive – a numerical prerequisite must be met. Students are limited to 3 AP classes per academic year. With approval, students may be granted permission to enroll in 4 AP classes.
