Family / Community Engagement Policy

Purpose: Our goal is to involve and inform parents of opportunities to partner with our school by being involved in the educational process of our children.

Protocol:

- Open door policy- teachers, admin, and staff are available for conference or information during the school day providing it doesn't interfere with the educational process; otherwise, a meeting will be scheduled. Parents will receive a response within 24 hour business day.
- Weekly communication- Teachers and staff will communicate through newsletters, Class Dojo, email, and Facebook page with upcoming events and important information. Monthly "blue note" will be sent. Mass notification throughout Connect-ed to notify parents of school events, reminders, news, etc.
- MTSS- Parents of at risk students are informed through a variety of methods. Parents of Tier 2 students will receive a letter informing them of the MTSS process. Parents of Tier 3 will be invited to a problem solving meeting.
- PTO members work to improve educational experiences through donations, raising funds, coordinating events, and volunteering throughout the school year. PTO meets monthly and any parent/guardian has an opportunity to participate. News from PTO will be shared on the "Blue note" and on Central PTO Facebook page.
