According to the Department, "The coveted National Blue Ribbon School award affirms the hard work of students, educators, families, and communities in creating safe and welcoming schools where students master challenging and engaging content."

The honor comes following an extensive application process of the combined efforts of High School Principal Julia Sniffen and the high school department chairs.
