

Car Rider Dismissal Procedures

The safety of our children at Widewater Elementary is our ultimate priority. We are diligently working to make our dismissal procedures as efficient as possible as we also work to ensure we socially distance our Wildcats even during dismissal. Students will be dismissed from their classrooms rather than gathered in the hallway which will most likely increase your wait time in our car rider line. Thank you for your patience and grace as we work to keep all of our Wildcats safe.

- This year, we will use **one car rider line** along the sidewalk. Please pull up to the white line or as close as possible to the car ahead of you and then place your car in Park.
- Display your **green car tag** in the windshield. If you do not have a tag, have a photo ID ready.
- **Stay in your car.** This will help in dismissing at a quicker pace as well as minimizing contact between individuals. Have your child practice opening the car door and buckling the seatbelt so they learn to do this independently.
- After your child has gotten in the car, **cars are to remain in line until they are directed to pull away by the traffic director.** Please be patient as this is for the safety of our students and staff.
- If a student has forgotten something and needs to return to the building, park in the main parking lot and accompany them to the front door and ring the bell for assistance from our office team.
- As a friendly reminder, **SMOKING AND/OR VAPING are not allowed** on school property, even if you are inside your own car. Thank you for following this SCPS school policy.
