COUNT DAY!

Count Day is October 4, 2023. This means that all researchers must attend (login) to Centric to be counted.

Please make sure each of the researchers follow these requirements ON count day:

1. Login to Centric.
2. Email, chat, text, or phone call their mentor and have an academic conversation about a specific project they are working on.
3. Submit 1 assignment (module step, check your learning activity, or final product) for each of the 6 classes on their Learning Plan.
 - a. 6 classes per Learning Plan = 6 separate assignments
 - b. All assignments must be submitted on Count Day, not before.
