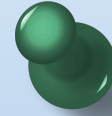
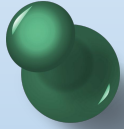

- should end the year with at least 230 credits in the appropriate subject areas to meet the High School graduation requirements.

G.	College Prep Elective	1 Year

*If student receives a **D or F** in an A-G course, it must be retaken for grade improvement to earn a **C or higher**

*If student receives an **F** in a core graduation requirement, it must be retaken to meet High School graduation requirements

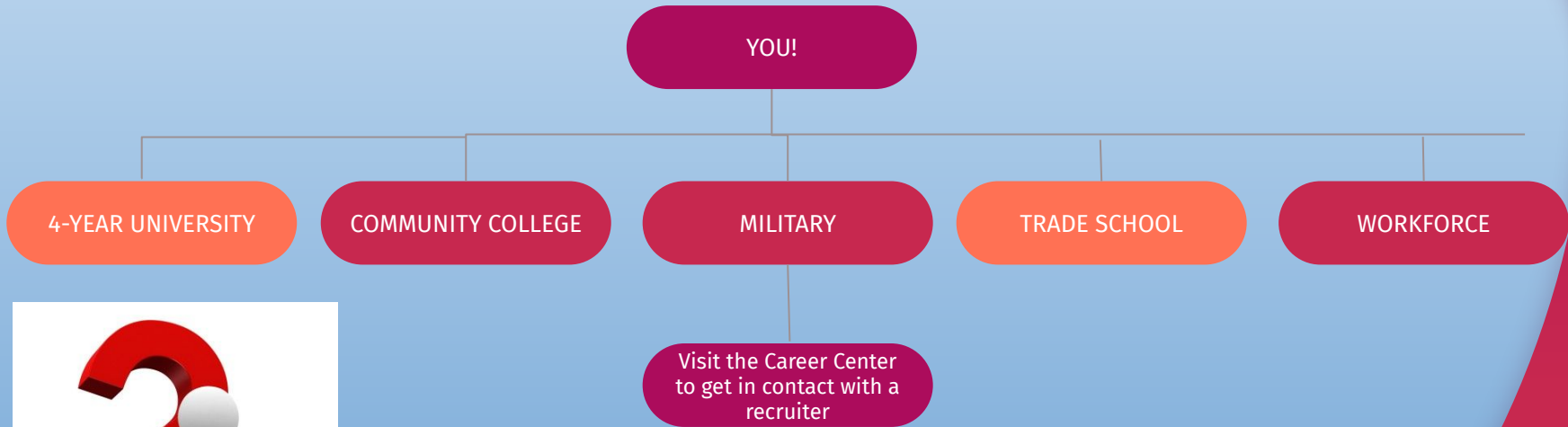

How do I apply for an ROP class?



- You can register with Ms. Garza in the Career Center or email liliana_garza@upland.k12.ca.us for the Spring Session.

Can I enroll in more than one course?

- Yes, you can enroll in multiple courses as long as the class schedules do not conflict.

Can I receive College credit?

- Yes! Many CTE courses have agreements in place to offer students college credits through various community colleges. Students earn college credits by completing specific requirements set forth in each class. **YOU ALSO RECEIVE HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS.**

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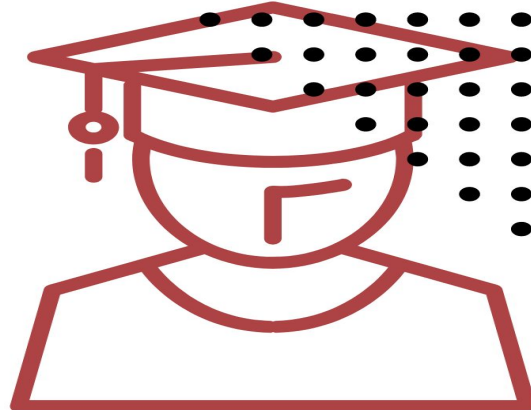
Dual Enrollment

SAT/ACT Testing

SAT: **Collegeboard.org**
ACT: **act.org**

- UC/CSU and junior/community colleges in California **will not use either test for admission** for students admitted to the 2023/2024 School Year.
- Private and out of state colleges may use the test (**it is up to you as a student to check the admission requirements for any college you apply to**).
- NCAA **will not be requiring** student athletes to take the SAT/ACT for Division I, II, and III schools.

College Deadlines

California Public Universities

University of California(UC): minimum 3.0 academic gpa and completion of A-G requirements, **October 1st thru November 30th**

California State University(CSU): minimum 2.50 academic gpa and completion of A-G requirements, **October 1st thru November 30th**



Private and Out-of-State Colleges

Deadlines will vary based on the college. It is up to you as a student to check the admission deadlines for these type of schools.

Some private schools give you two other options when you apply:

1. **Early decision** plans are **binding** — a student who is accepted as an early decision applicant must attend the college.
2. **Early action** plans are **non-binding** — students receive an early response to their application, but do not have to commit to the college until the normal reply date of May 1

College Application Info & Workshops

- **College Application workshops:**
- Starting October 9th through December 1 we will be holding application workshops in the Counseling Classroom (C108) to help students with their college applications

Letters of Recommendations:

- Not needed for UC or CSU, Junior colleges, but please check private colleges and/or out of state colleges for requirements
- Best letters are from people who can speak to the students academic performance
- **If counselor letter of recommendation is specifically required, students must complete and submit letter of recommendation request packet (located in your counselors google classroom).**

Deadline is 10/1/23 11:59pm.
