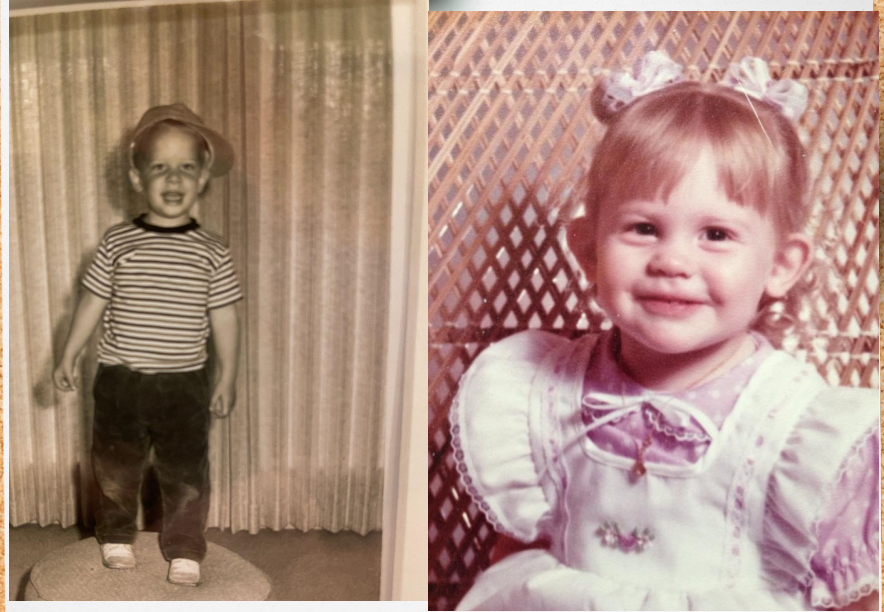

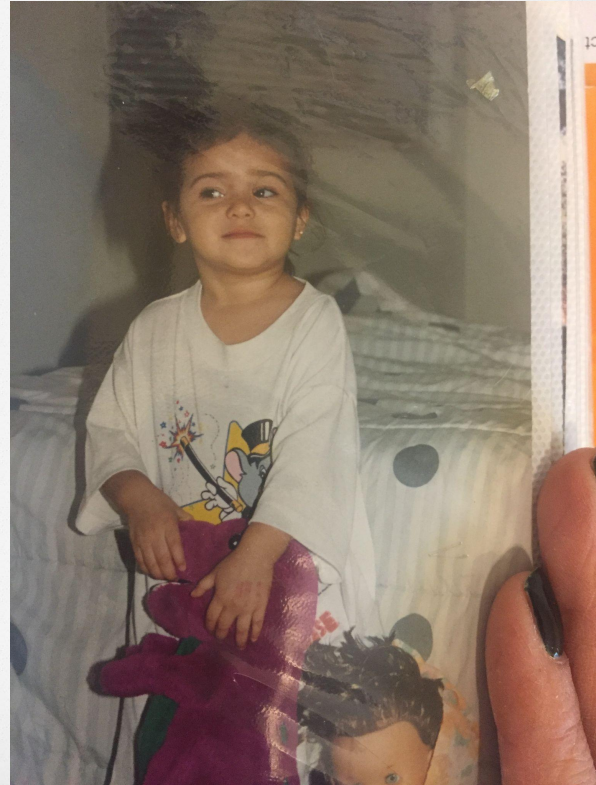

## Earning Credits:

Five credits are awarded at the end of each semester for every class passed; 230 credits are required for graduation






# Graduation Requirements

- 
- ✓ History 30 credits (3 years)
  - ✓ English 40 credits (4 years)
  - ✓ Math 20 credits (2 years)
  - ✓ Science 20 credits (2 years)
  - ✓ Fine Arts/ 10 credits (1 year)

## CTE/World Language

- ✓ P.E. 20 credits (2 years)
- ✓ Electives 90 credits
- ✓ 230 total credits and Algebra I required for graduation






\*If student receives an F in a core graduation requirement, it must be retaken


\*If student receives a D or F in an A-G course, it must be retaken

\*Night School, Summer School and Apex are options to make up classes

How do I apply for an ROP class?

- You can register with Ms. Garza in the Career Center or email [liliana\\_garza@upland.k12.ca.us](mailto:liliana_garza@upland.k12.ca.us) for the Spring Session.

Can I enroll in more than one course?

- Yes, you can enroll in multiple courses as long as the class schedules do not conflict.


Can I receive College credit?

- Yes! Many CTE courses have agreements in place to offer students college credits through various community colleges. Students earn college credits by completing specific requirements set forth in each class. **YOU ALSO RECEIVE HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS.**

  - **RESEARCH** shows that students who participate in Dual Enrollment programs are more likely to graduate from high school and persist in college!

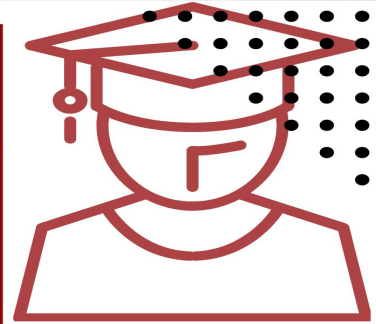
