PRINCIPAL’S MESSAGE

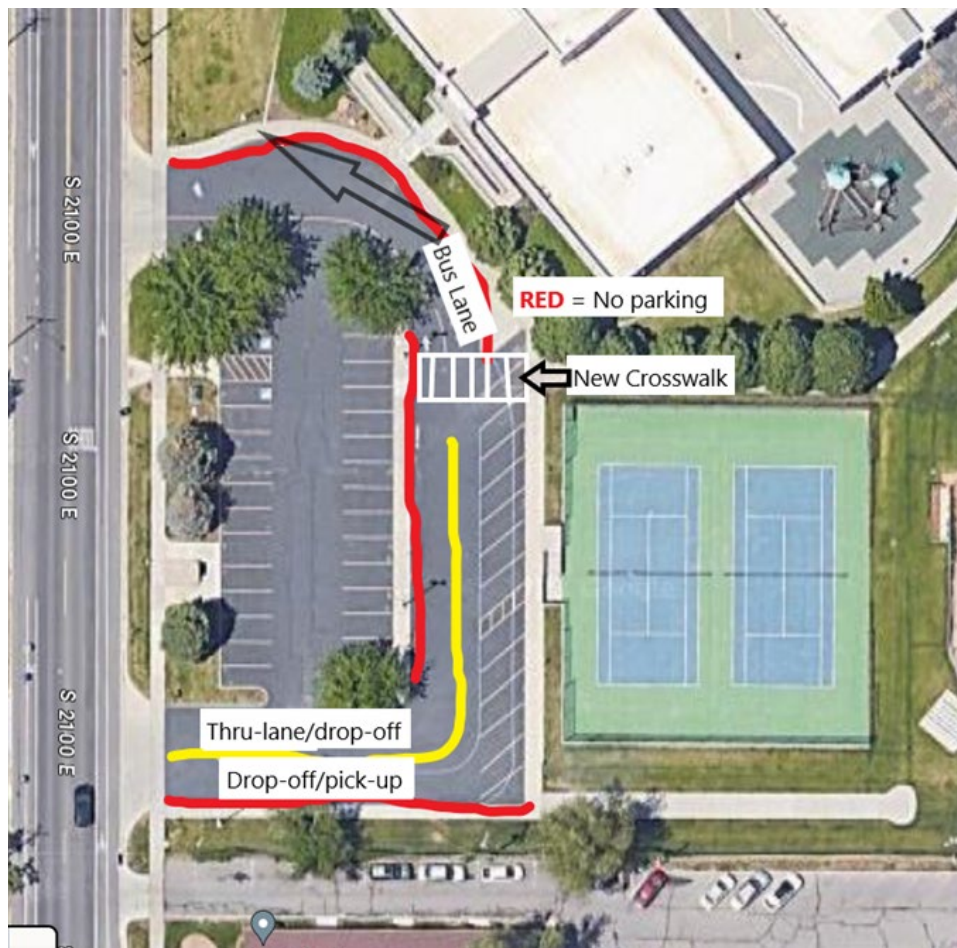
Dear Parents,

To increase safety, the district has added some fresh paint and some slight changes to our west parking lot on 2100 East, and we want to clarify parking lot expectations during drop off and dismissal. Some hot spots we are trying to improve are below:

1. Parking in red zones. Please, do not park in a red zone during drop off or dismissal—this includes sitting in your car while parked at dismissal. This disrupts traffic flow in the thru-lane and bus lanes and creates an overcrowded parking lot that is unsafe for the children. If you need to get out of your car, please park in the spaces provided or across the street at the church.
2. Using our new crosswalk in the parking lot. We want all kids and families to be safe walking through our parking lot, so please use the new crosswalk added this weekend.
3. The Drop-off/Pick-up Lane. The drop-off/pick-up lane should be utilized for those things only. We will soon be removing the angled parking spaces so that we do not have cars backing up into the lanes. We understand that at dismissal you will be temporarily parked there while you wait. We ask parents who need to leave their cars to use the available parking spaces or park at the church across the street.
4. The Thru-Lane. This is for traffic driving through. After you have picked up your child, then please pull to the left to leave. You are welcome to use this lane as a drop off lane in the morning, however, please make sure kids are exiting to the left and walking down to the crosswalk before crossing.
