## Logging into Your Chromebook

- 1. Plug in your charger into the Chromebook.
- 2. Your device should power on after lifting the top cover. This means that it is charged.
- 3. However, if your device does not power on, then push the power button 0 on the upper right-hand corner of the keyboard to turn on your device.
- 4. Make sure that you can connect to your home Wi-Fi or the district issued hot spot (directions for using the district issued hot spot are included)
- 5. When your machine is powering on, you will see this screen:
