VII. UPDATES

a. CTE Incentive Grant

- Application was revised and submitted in June

- Allocating more funds consisting of new request with updates
- All districts had to reapply
- Funding will be for this year although it will arrive late
- b. Perkins V**
 - \$109,000 allocated this year
 - Last year the total was \$ \$106,000
 - No significant funding changes
- c. K12 SWP Grant 20-21 Round 3**
 - Building or expanding pathways
 - \$900,000 Grant expanding offerings at the Middle and High Schools- 30 month spending plan
- d. K12 SWP Application 21-22 Round 4**
 - \$664,000 for Auto Shop at Bellflower High School
 - o Snap On will be doing all cabinets in the Auto Shop room
 - o The program will apply for ASE certification
 - ASE will allow for car donations
 - Within 50 miles of BUSD only 3 auto programs are certified
 - The goal is to align the new auto courses with Cerritos College
 - Applied for two new grants –
 - o Bio-Animation, Robotics, specific to health – solving health related problems, i.e. Prosthetics
 - o Energy and utilities – Cerritos College will partner with us in the new pathway development

VIII. CULINARY CLASS AT BHS

- The Advisory Meeting took place in the new culinary lab
- Ordered stainless steel tables for room – due to arrive soon
- Goal is to articulate courses or offer dual enrollment with Cerritos College

IX. UPDATE STEAM BUILDING AT MHS

- Will hold Math, Science, CTE, and Art Academy classrooms
- Teachers work in a collaborative environment
- STEAM building originally scheduled to be done in April- extended to Fall 2022
