Almost 100 years old, we draw on our proud heritage as **the first British School in Latin America to be recognised as a British School Overseas (BSO) by the UK government.**

Pupils at St. Paul's School benefit from both its rich history and its innovative, modern facilities. The school occupies the same 1.8-hectare site acquired in 1927 and is situated in the leafy residential area aptly named Jardins. The school is organised on the English public school model. **English is the language of instruction at St. Paul's (K-12)**

CURRICULUM

St. Paul's School provides a carefully structured, integrated and diversified curriculum. The school's curriculum has its foundation in the English National Curriculum incorporating the UK National Curriculum, Cambridge IGCSEs and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. We also incorporate the requirements laid out by the Brazilian Core Curriculum.

Pupils prepare for IGCSE courses in Form 4 and Form 5 (Y10 & 11, Grades 9 &10). All those in Lower and Upper 6 (Y12 &13, Grades 11 & 12), take the full IB Diploma.

The school also offers a full enrichment programme, which includes a wide range of clubs and societies and a house system, as well as ample opportunities to develop skills in creative arts, music, and sports, both inside and outside the classroom. This programme underpins our aims to instill a life-long love for learning, self-development, and a belief in one's abilities in all pupils.




