The budget development process begins in early to mid January and lasts up to the day of the budget vote.

District employees involved in the budget development process are the Superintendent, District Treasurer, District Principal, IT Director(area specific), Head of Buildings and grounds(area specific), District Nurse(area specific). The school board reviews and comments on the budget up to four times before the budget is adopted. Amagansett Union Free School District is a preK-Grade school, no individual building and/or school site needs representation.

No formula is needed to allocate funds to individual schools, Amagansett Union Free School District is a one building school.
