NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that as a result of a tie vote between two (2) candidates for the Board of Education at the annual election held on May 21, 2019, a run-off election will be held to elect one (1) candidate for a three (3) year term from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022, and one (1) candidate to fill the balance of an unexpired term commencing on June 25, 2019 through June 30, 2020. The candidate receiving the largest number of votes will be elected to the longer term and the other candidate will be elected to fill the balance of the unexpired term. - A lease or rental agreement; •
- A utility bill showing a physical address within the district; •
- Suffolk County voter registration card showing a physical address within the district; •
- A recent income tax return showing a physical address within the district; •
- A current paycheck stub showing your name and physical address within the district; or .
- Documentation illustrating that you are receiving public assistance benefits at a physical address within the district.

The register prepared will be filed in the office of the Clerk of the District and will be open for inspection by any qualified voter of the District during business hours on each of the five (5) days prior to and on the day set for the election, except Saturday when it will be available for inspection between 10:00 AM and 12:00 Noon, prevailing time, by appointment, and Sunday.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that in accordance with Education Law §2018-a, absentee ballots are obtainable from the District Clerk. The District Clerk must receive completed applications at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. No absentee voter's ballot shall be canvassed unless it shall have been received in the office of the Clerk of the District not later than 5:00 PM on the day of the election. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots have been issued, will be available in the office of the Clerk of the District on each of the five (5) days prior to the day of the election, except Saturday, when it will be available for inspection between 10:00 AM and 12:00 Noon by appointment.
