INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the Round Lake High School Crashbar Alarms and additional access control, including Maglock, for the Round Lake Area Schools Community Unit School District #116, as described below will be received at the Round Lake Area Schools CUSD #116 Operations Service Center, 811 Sunset Drive, Round Lake, IL 60073 until 12 noon, local time, Tuesday, May 9, 2023. At 1:00 PM, all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Maintenance Warehouse, 719 Valentin Drive, Round Lake, IL, 60073. Sealed envelopes are to be marked "Sealed Bid for SD116 RLHS CRASHBAR ALARMS, including MAGLOCK and ADDITIONAL ACCESS CONTROL" and submitted to the Attention of Dr. Pamela Kibbons.

Electronic Bid Documents may be obtained, starting at 9:00 AM on Wednesday, April 26, 2023, on the Round Lake Areas Schools CUSD #116 District website, Operations Tab-select Business Office. Hard Copies of the Bid Documents are not available.

This project includes, but is not limited to, the following work items: adding audible alarms, with Maglock, to a maximum of thirty-three (33) existing exterior door crashbars and additional card access to exterior doors not already controlled by the Avigilon access control system,

Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond, Bank Cashier's Check, or Certified Check in the amount of TEN (10) percent of the total bid amount, made payable to the Round Lake Area Schools CUSD #116 shall accompany the bid.

There will be a MANDATORY Pre-Bid Walk-Thru Meeting for all interested bidders. Any prime bidder submitting a bid on this project must attend this meeting. Location and time are as follows:

Factors other than price which will be considered in awarding or rejecting bids shall include the results of reference contacts, and the quality of the bidder's performance on prior projects, if any, in the judgment of the School District. All proposals submitted shall be valid for a period of 90 days.
