## 2023-2024 SCHOOL PROFILE

### District Information

Plattsmouth Community Schools has a K-4 elementary school, a 5-8 middle school, and a 9-12 high school. For the 2023-2024 school year the enrollment for these three schools is 1,363 students. All three schools are Frameworks accredited. In addition, there is a Head Start program, preschool program for special needs students, and an Administration Center.

### Class Periods

Plattsmouth's school year is divided into two semesters with a total of 174 instructional days. Classes meet every other day for a block for the length of a semester. Each student has eight class periods and one Advisory period. Students earn five credits for the successful completion of most semester courses.
