What's the difference?

Community Colleges

4- year Institutions (UC/CSU's, Out-of-state, etc.)

Trade or Vocational School

Earn an A.A. or A.S. (associate's degree), certificate, or licensure

Earn a undergraduate degree which is a B.A. or B.S. (bachelor's degree) Earn a certificate (not a degree)

California Community College System



- Community College *registration* opens during <u>Spring 2024</u> for incoming freshman.
- DVC will be hosting workshops to help you enroll.
- Registration info will be posted in the College & Career classroom
- **DVC Free Tuition Program:** To receive free tuition for up to two academic years, CCC, DVC, and LMC students must: 1) Complete FAFSA or Dream Act and 2) Enroll in a minimum of 12 units per semester.
- No SAT or ACT is required for acceptance.



WHERE DO UC YOURSELF?

University of California (UC)

9 UC Campuses throughout California

Requirements:

- Minimum 3.0 gpa (10th & 11th grade only)
- No subject tests (SAT, ACT) are required
- UC application (same application for all campuses)
- 4 Personal Insight Questions (pick 4 out of 8)
- \$80 fee per campus
- *UC San Francisco is only a graduate program
- NO letters of recommendation required

<u> Application filing period: October 1 - November 30</u>

California State University (CSU)

23 CSU Campuses throughout California

Requirements:

- Minimum 2.5 gpa (10th-11th grade only)
- Application (same application for all campuses)
- \$70 fee per campus
- NO letters of recommendation
- NO essay

Application filing period: October 1 - November 30



Private Colleges & Universities

GPA and course requirements vary greatly, check each college website!

<u>All schools require:</u>

- **Common application** (apply to multiple schools at same time) or college specific application
- Send official test scores**
- Pay application fee
- Personal statement or essay
- Letters of recommendation (0-3 max)

Application filing periods vary!



Historically Black Colleges & Universities (HBCU's)

Historically Black colleges and universities are institutions of higher education founded **to educate Black students**. In the 19th century, when many colleges and universities refused to admit Black applicants, HBCU's offered those students a route to higher education. Anyone can apply to HBCU's!







Out of State Colleges

Non-residents often have additional or different requirements at public universities

WUE: Western Undergraduate Exchange

Students can apply for reduced tuition at participating schools within 15 Western States

Examples of colleges:

- University of Hawaii
- Colorado State University
- UNR
- University of Nevada, Las Vegas
- Portland State University

Students who initially enroll full time and intend to play NCAA Division I or II athletics <u>will not be required</u> to take a standardized test to meet NCAA initial-eligibility requirements.



- **G** Faculty : Student ratio
- Diversity
- Selectivity
- **Type of College (2-year, 4-year, Vocational)**
- Graduation Rates (National Center for Education Statistics - NCES)
- Create a list of 8 10 colleges that you want to apply to
 - Best Fit
 - Safety
 - Reach

Letters of Recommendations

From Teachers:

- Need to be requested in Naviance
- Complete brag sheet
- Let your teacher know in person, or via email, that you are requesting a letter of recommendation (At least 3 weeks ahead of time)
- Please do not ask for more than is needed

From your Counselor/College & Career Advisor

- Request in person, via email Ask early, (3 weeks is ideal) - Cannot be requested in Naviance
- Complete brag sheet in and send to Counselor
- Be available for follow-up questions
- Last minute requests cannot be accommodated
- Please do not ask for more than is needed

FAFSA/California Dream Act (CADA)

Mandatory for all students to complete!

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is for 4-year Colleges, Community Colleges, Adult School programs, and Trade Schools
