




What Are SICs Intended To Do? Provide input and feedback on school strategic improvement plans and updates Assist the school in implementing various improvement activities Monitor and report on school progress toward improvement goals "Civic Engagement at Work for Public Education"








(C) **Virtual SIC Elections** SICs can function even during social distancing √ While large in-person events are curtailed, SICs can hold parent elections with online tools; include an option for families without technology √ Teachers can nominate/elect in virtual faculty meetings Student SIC elections can be combined with the school's virtual student body elections or held in a separate virtual SIC election




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
