Misericordia University recognizes the importance of participating in the civic process of voting for our elected officials. That's why we encourage our students to get registered, to get out there, and to be heard. To vote in federal, state and municipal elections, you must be a registered voter.

Steps you can take to ensure you are ready to vote:

1. Check your Voter Registration

2. Register to Vote
 - a. If you are not registered to vote find out how to register in the state that you live at <https://vote.gov/>

 - c. Pennsylvania Online Voter Registration can be found at <https://www.pavoterservices.pa.gov/Pages/VoterRegistrationApplication.aspx>
 - d. Students whose permanent address is out of state but who live in PA (on or off campus) while attending college and wish to register to vote with their PA address need to submit a PA voter registration application.

3. Research the Ballot
