Message from

Last week, while standing at our Loudoun Road entrance, I watched lower schoolers arrive. Amid the flurry of backpack checks, goodbyes and embraces was the palpable and noteworthy joy of our youngest students. Whether skipping, hopping, running or walking into school, students were excited and ready to find out what the new school day would bring.

That our school is such a joyful setting reflects many things, including our extraordinary resources and programs, which the superlative generosity captured in *A Celebration of Giving 2022-23* makes possible. Such kindness is invaluable for the School's well-being, and I am grateful for the philanthropic spirit I have already witnessed at ASL.

That spirit fuels participation, and last year more than 800 members of the community (including 86% of our employees) contributed to what became £1.71M raised for the ASL Foundation's Annual Fund. Through grant-making programs, the Fund supports many crucial needs at ASL, including classroom upgrades, new cultural activities for students, increased opportunities in the visual and performing arts, and greater financial aid.

What also fuels, and is critical for, our success: dedicated volunteers, who are active in varied ways—as trustees, and leaders and members of the PCA. Under the leadership of Lesley and Barrie Davison P '29 '33, Emma and David Rhodes P '25 '27, and Kate and Steve Albrecht P '26 '26, more than 65 parents/guardians and alumni served as Annual Fund volunteers. I offer my heartfelt thanks to each of them for their support and their endless encouragement to others to participate at any level.

Last year also saw the return of the PCA auction, which brought our community together, raising an impressive £1.17M. The proceeds supported improvements to the gyms, and the Eagle Scholarship program, and cover the PCA's operating budget for the next two years. This event was possible and successful because of the tireless leadership of Maria Thakrar P '29 '31 and Eve Share Banghart P '31 '34 and countless volunteer hours provided by parents and guardians.

Beyond these two funds, another £1.08M was raised in support of Special Initiatives, including the Innovator-in-Residence program, increased support for Computer Science, and our work to meet the needs of students with Specific Learning Differences (SLD).

In total in 2022-23, £3.96M was raised in philanthropic support, an impressive figure that reflects generosity and commitment. I am eager for you to read the stories in this report, ones that showcase what's possible at ASL because of your dedication to the School. These stories and your support make me want to skip into the building!

If we haven't yet met, I hope that we will in the coming days. In the meantime, please know how much I appreciate your generous participation.






Specific Learning Differences

Celebrating all styles of learning

Our Specific Learning Differences (SLD) program has benefitted from a financial boost thanks to generous gifts from committed parents, whose families have experienced, first hand, the impact of this valued program.

The SLD program is part of the broader multi-tiered system of support at ASL, designed to encourage student growth and development. SLD classes provide individualized, targeted intervention for students who have been diagnosed with a specific learning difference. The program addresses their particular style of learning, and helps students to develop effective skills to enable them to thrive at ASL.

The SLD program is one way that ASL strives to live its mission of inclusivity. Fundraising to grow the SLD endowment will ensure the future of the SLD program, and reinforce our commitment to students with learning differences. Moving forward, as we grow the SLD endowment, the longevity of the program will be protected and ensured, enabling ASL students to have access to this essential support.

In 2022-23, Chelsea and Jon Heuer P '27 '29 '37 made a generous contribution to establish the Heuer Family Specific Learning Differences Endowment Fund, to support the SLD program at ASL. This fund helps reinforce the School's commitment to providing educational support to allow each student to perform at the highest possible academic level.

Chelsea and Jon explained their reasons for supporting this important program at ASL: “Children with learning differences have unique abilities that allow them to see the world differently, fostering creativity and out-of-the-box thinking. The SLD program at ASL is exceptional in that it gives these children the chance to learn and succeed alongside their peers, and at the same school as their siblings. Our hope is that this program continues to grow and promotes an inclusive community of learners and innovators at ASL.”

Another family, with students in the classes of 2022 and 2025, donated to the program. They shared, “The bond that truly inspirational

teachers sometimes form with their students is unique. It has been our experience that even this exceptional relationship has been well surpassed with both our children and their SLD mentor. To say their journeys through SLD were formative and transformative is not an understatement. Our children say so themselves at every opportunity and for this we are exceedingly grateful.”

Parents of alumni Bonnie and Derek Bandeen P '07 '11 '12 '17 have long been supporters of this invaluable asset at ASL. They write, “The SLD program was an outstanding resource for our children, helping them to develop the necessary skills to thrive in a challenging academic environment and providing them a safe space to explore and better understand their learning differences. Importantly, never were they made to feel any kind of stigma about their involvement in the program. The SLD program has consistently proved to be a great asset to the School and its students.”

The SLD program goes from strength to strength, and for the support of our families who show their appreciation by giving to allow the program to continue its great work with students, we are enormously grateful.

Learning from our neurodivergent community

Students benefiting from the SLD program are keen to spread the word and raise awareness about the experiences of neurodivergent students at ASL. Owing to the dedication of the high school Neurodiversity Club, March saw the third annual Neurodiversity Celebration Week return to ASL—bigger and better than ever.

Activities included an interactive question-and-answer session in the Mellon Library, hosted by four members of the Neurodiversity Club. Students shared their educational experiences and learning journeys with guests, then opened the floor for questions from employees, parents/guardians and fellow students. Another involved six students leading conversations on various neurodiversity topics, such as autism spectrum disorder (ASD), ADHD, dyslexia and more. Resources to browse between discussions included books featuring conversations on neurodiversity. The objective of both events was to build a welcoming community within ASL for all neurodiverse constituents.

Annesley '24, co-founder of the Neurodiversity Club enthused, “I like planning events and definitely have a passion for raising awareness around neurodiversity. Thanks to help from Ms. Statz and the rest of the SLD team, the events went amazingly well and each had a great turnout! We wanted the events to be a lot more interactive this year, and I think we definitely achieved that.”

It's estimated that one in seven people are neurodivergent, with some type of SLD. It's important to highlight the strengths that come with neurodiversity as well as the struggles—such as perseverance and the ability to share their experiences, as well as acting as a role model for younger neurodivergent students.



PCA Auction

Proving we're Better Together!

March saw the welcome return of one of ASL's most joyous traditions: the PCA auction. It had been four long years since the last auction, and as a community, we were more than ready to prove the claim behind the name of this year's event—*Better Together*—a fabulous community-building celebration, which raised £1.17M. Led by co-chairs Eve Share Banghart P '31 '34 and Maria Thakrar P '29 '31 and an incredibly supportive team of willing volunteers, the auction took place over two days, beginning with a community lunch on Friday, 17 March, in the Farmer Family Gymnasium, which was accompanied by a silent auction, and followed by a lively kids' party and live class basket raffle. Saturday, 18 March, saw the event move to the Natural History Museum, which played host for the first time to the auction gala evening. This spectacular gathering included a formal dinner and culminated in a live auction followed by an after-party.



Funds raised go toward covering the PCA's operating expenditure for the next two years, as well as funding key areas at ASL. *Better Together* raised funds for the Eagle Scholarship Fund, an initiative that supports students from UK schools local to ASL, who have the potential to thrive in the challenging and nurturing environment of our school, regardless of their family's financial situation. The auction also contributed toward the cost of the refurbishment of PE teaching and learning spaces.

Thank you to Eve and Maria and the PCA team for their dedication to ASL in bringing this community-building experience to our school. And our sincere gratitude to all those who showed their support by raising the paddle, buying a count-me-in ticket, making a bid online or at the live auction, or donating an item to *Better Together*!

Innovator in Residence

Making an impact with creative thinking

The ASL Innovator-in-Residence (IIR) program is a dynamic and enriching annual initiative that brings in forward-thinking, creative and knowledgeable individuals to collaborate with students, teachers and administrators. The program aims to foster a culture of innovation and critical thinking within our school community. Students get a glimpse into real-world challenges and potential career paths, encouraging a stronger connection between classroom learning and the outside world.

The program was introduced in 2019-20 following a generous gift from an anonymous donor, and fully funded in perpetuity in 2022-23 through the kindness of another donor wishing to remain anonymous. Additional funding has been received through these initial years from other generous gifts to the program. We are grateful for the commitment of these families whose vision benefits our students. Through this permanent endowment, our students have direct access to inspirational leaders in diverse fields, promoting a culture of innovation that prepares them to thrive in an ever-changing world.

Our most recent donor, whose support has enabled this program to grow, shared, “Our older children have already benefited enormously from their time at ASL, and we are excited about our little ones starting their journey at ASL soon. One of the many things we admire about the School is how it seeks to inspire the students to be creative and imaginative while finding their passions. This ethos is encapsulated

in the Innovator-in-Residence program, which has introduced many amazingly creative and inspirational leaders to ASL students since its launch. We are proud to support this program and look forward to seeing even more evidence of its hugely positive impact on ASL students in the years to come.”

A heartfelt thank you to the families who have chosen to show their commitment to the Innovator-in-Residence program and allowing innovation to flourish at ASL.


Innovation and entrepreneurship

Our Innovator in Residence 2022-23, Francesco Tamburrino, worked alongside Computer Science Department Head Livia Piloto (ASL 2015-present) to run an entrepreneurship program for a group of high school students over the course of the year. The students met every other week to learn about this exciting topic and create their own businesses. They began by generating and selecting ideas, carried out market research, and decided on two different ideas for startups. Students were given a budget to enable them to hire professionals to make their ideas come to life, and created pitches for an internal panel of faculty. Following up from their feedback, they further refined their ideas. To conclude the project, two companies were created, and the students were able to reflect on the lessons they had learned throughout the process. In addition to his time with students, in May, Francesco took part in a panel discussion on artificial intelligence, as part of ASL Speakers Series.

Robotics

Evolution and outreach

“Robotics is one more example of how ASL excels at preparing students for the real world.”

Last year, 195 students in Grades 4-12 and 10 mentors (including four alumni!) participated in robotics activities. They connect socially in a safe environment and develop collaborative and creative skills, while increasing levels of self-confidence, leadership and teamwork. Through partnership programming, special events, competitions and weekly building sessions, students engage in problem-solving and collaboration, working together to tackle shared challenges.

Robotics at ASL flourished in 2022-23. A new initiative in the High School, Robotics:Outreach, drew much acclaim and there are great plans to build on these solid foundations in the years ahead.

Thanks to a donation from a generous family, major expansion of this outstanding program has helped our outreach to grow. This gift supported the current robotics core budget. In addition, an associated matching grant will provide Robotics:Outreach at four local schools, including robotics kits and adult support for mentorship.

As part of Robotics:Outreach, our students delivered weekly robotics enrichment activities to students from George Eliot and Holy Trinity CofE primary schools. In fact, the ASL robotics team won their regional competition this past year, largely based on this commendable outreach work. The student outreach

coordinator also won an individual award for their dedication and commitment to the project.

A family whose generosity has contributed so much to the evolution of this tremendous opportunity at ASL shared, “The Robotics program—one of the best among UK schools—is innovative, energizing and exciting. But the best part is that it embodies ASL’s core values and pedagogy, including collaboration, responsibility, growth mindset and the freedom to make and learn from mistakes. We also love the outreach element, taking the program to state primary schools in our neighborhood and making a meaningful difference to our wider community.”

The program goes to great lengths to prepare participating students for life beyond ASL. Another family that has chosen to generously support robotics at our school wrote, “Robotics is one more example of how ASL excels at preparing students for the real world. Students must learn to dream, lead, collaborate, fundraise, design, build, fail, rebound and play to win with tight deadlines and budgets.”

One avenue the team is keen to explore is that of creating an XR Lab at ASL. XR, or extended reality, encompasses augmented reality (AR), virtual reality (VR), and mixed reality or mediated reality (MR). This lab would combine the benefits of VR and AR to create something groundbreaking for our students. Not only would they be able to experience what it is like to view the workings of an aircraft, for example, but they would also be able to work on an engineering project and make modifications and experience the consequences.

Robotics Program Director Muktar Ali (ASL 2012-18; 2022-present) is excited about the possibilities this transformational opportunity could bring to the School and our students: “This is really cool stuff if you are thinking of becoming an engineer. It is hard, if not impossible, to experience these situations first hand, so being able to gain access via a headset is phenomenal. Having these tools and use-case scenarios would be taking something inaccessible and bringing it into the classroom.”

On a smaller scale, the Lower School is already exploring this technology. The After-school Program course Virtual & Augmented Reality Design sees students jump into the developer seat. Our young engineers build skills that empower them to design and create anything in their imagination. From designing 3D tree houses and interactive mazes, to creating 3D works of art or even an entire solar system! Students get to harness technology to explore their creativity in a whole new way, while gaining confidence as well as improving their digital literacy.

Designing, building, testing and deploying a successful robot that tackles concrete problems in a controlled environment provides the catalyst for collegiality and creativity in the students’ pursuit of a common goal. Students are benefiting from the academic and social skills required for problem-solving and design-based learning, skills that will help them to thrive in other areas of life.

We remain incredibly grateful to the generous donors who contribute to the evolution of this popular program at ASL.

Giving back to ASL: A community of lifelong learners

The Mentzer family moved to London from Houston, Texas, in 2000 when parents Beverly and Ray Mentzer P '07 '12 took up new engineering assignments in London. Along with their children, Nate '07 and Rebecca '12, they stayed for four years.

Ray shares his memories of the family’s time in London: “We enjoyed exploring the city and touring the UK, as well as traveling farther afield to Africa. Nate joined the rugby team, a sport he enjoyed through college. He spent his 12th birthday in Greece! Rebecca loved drama and took advantage of London’s museums.”

When asked what they miss most about those ASL years, Ray is quick to respond, “The wide variety of diverse cultural experiences both within the School and in London, which enabled us to connect with parents from a host of countries and cultures.” He adds, “We gained a deep appreciation for the experiences of people from

different backgrounds, and a better understanding of the American culture as seen through the eyes of others. As a family, we found volunteering at the American Church Soup Kitchen incredibly rewarding, and both our children developed empathy for the homeless—something they carried forward into adulthood. Nate met his wife through a church group ministering to the needs of others, and Rebecca has traveled far and wide helping the less fortunate lift themselves out of poverty.”

Total philanthropic support

The Annual Fund is the keystone of the ASL Foundation’s fundraising efforts and participation and support is encouraged from every member of the ASL community. Through grant-making, the Fund contributes a vital 4% of the operating budget and each year it provides the margin of excellence that epitomizes an ASL education. In 2022-23, our community supported the ASL Foundation’s Annual Fund with 818 gifts, from £5 to £100,000, and totalling more than £1.71M.

Special initiatives are specific, short-term projects that facilitate program expansion or campus enhancement at ASL. Senior leadership and the Board of Trustees identify specific needs

and seek restricted contributions from the ASL community that give promise of improved learning. This targeted fundraising is above and beyond revenue generated by the Annual Fund. In 2022-23, £1.08M was donated to support special initiatives in computer science, crew, facilities, the Innovator-in-Residence program, robotics, security/cyber security, and Specific Learning Differences (SLD).

The PCA *Better Together* Auction raised funds for the Eagle Scholarship program and refurbishments of PE teaching and learning spaces, as well as supporting the PCA’s operating expenses for the next two years.

Total philanthropic support is a combination of gifts to the Annual Fund and special initiatives, and funds raised by the PCA Auction.
