






Computer science gets a boost!

Thanks to a generous donation from Lisa and Rick Noel P '17 '19 '21 and their daughters, Claire '17, Lily '19 and Eva '21, computer science has been given a substantial boost at ASL.

The expansion of ASL's computer science program will create authentic opportunities and increase students' exposure to specialized fields, such as artificial intelligence, game design, cyber security and virtual reality. Funding from this generous gift will not only significantly improve and deepen the high school computer science department, it will also allow the program to be expanded K-12. The growth of computer science will provide a gender equitable pipeline for all of our students.

Lisa and Rick Noel shared their thoughts behind their generosity to the ASL computer science program: "Following the girls' graduation from ASL, we wanted to recognize the positive impact the School had on our children. Computer science is a subject that we are passionate about as a family, and in collaboration with the School, we came up with tangible ideas of what was possible. We wanted to support a program that would be attractive and accessible to all students, and able to expand to include the lower grades creating multiple opportunities for future computer/data scientists. If successful, we envision ASL becoming known for its computer science and computational thinking program."







A fast-growing area of study

Computer science has been offered at ASL for decades. Since its humble beginnings, offerings have blossomed from two sections of electives attended by a handful of students, to 10 courses covering not only coding but also engineering design, art and code, game design, digital electronics, and much more. Supporting this growth now requires the coordination of five different instructors, which has led to the designation as a new academic department in the High School for 2022-23. What's more, the department is working to support computational thinking and computer science awareness in the Lower and Middle schools.

Getting with the program

More than just coding, computer science involves the study of computation and its application in the world. Aspects of computer science include the study of programming languages, the design and analysis of algorithms, the development of intelligent systems, and the design of electrical hardware on which computation is to be performed. Learning to break down really big problems into manageable chunks (problem decomposition) is a major component of computer science and a key skill. Thinking through the necessary steps needed to complete a task and the order in which they need to be performed (algorithm development) is a second learning outcome. Recognizing patterns in solutions to problems and applying those solutions in new contexts is a third skill students develop. Finally, thinking at the right level of detail needed to solve a problem (abstraction) is a lasting benefit from computer science education.

21st-century thinking

Intelligent systems and the algorithms that drive them pervade our society, influencing the news we see, moderating our connections with loved ones and friends, managing public health, transportation and logistic systems, and more. Our view of the world is shaped by these algorithms and the way they collect and process information. Having a basic understanding of algorithms is therefore critical knowledge for effective citizenship. Furthermore, computer science provides insights into how we might design technology to address the political, cultural and ecological challenges of this century. Even if a student completes just one programming course at ASL, they will leave thinking about the world a little differently.

Head of Computer Science Livia Piloto enthuses, "We're very excited about computer science becoming its own department because we can now focus more on curating our courses to be as relevant as the ever-changing technological world. We will also learn how to best fit the needs of our students with regard to university choices, and have them feel confident and prepared to go out into the world."



Active in body, mind and spirit

Our goal at ASL has always been to offer a comprehensive physical education (PE) program that encourages fitness and the mastery of physical skills, which instill confidence in our students both in and out of the classroom.

It was this aspiration that brought about digging below Waverley Park to add our state-of-the-art Aquatic & Fitness Center as part of our *New Frontiers* capital campaign. This first-class facility, with its 25-meter, sixlane swimming pool and flexible gym space, enables us to offer all five strands of PE and, most importantly, gives us the flexibility in the schedule to make our students' academic experience the best it can be.



These flexible spaces are also used for athletics, assemblies, robotics competitions, community service days, PCA events, community partnerships, and by friends of the School, such as London Sports.

The PE program at ASL is designed to provide a framework for students to pursue lifetime fitness and physical activity. In preparation for adulthood, students enhance their skills in a variety of physical activities. Students are expected to acquire knowledge of training principles and methods, and apply their understanding in the development and review of a personal fitness program. Through participation, students develop an appreciation of the value of physical activity, not only for its health benefits, but also as a unique setting for social interaction, challenge and self-expression.

At ASL, students participate in PE every other day, and take full advantage of the Farmer Family Gymnasium, the newly refurbished Blue Gym (complete with a blue floor once more—freshly poured this summer), and Multipurpose Room 2. In addition, we've enjoyed six wonderful years of our Aquatic & Fitness Center, made possible by the generosity of those who gave to New Frontiers; six years of students enjoying this top-flight facility right here on Waverley Place. How lucky we are. These flexible spaces are also used for athletics, assemblies, robotics competitions, community service days, PCA events, community partnerships, and by friends of the School, such as London Sports. The upkeep of these spaces is supported by our generous donors to the Annual Fund.



Crew

An 'oar-some' year for crew!

Our ASL crew program is a rapidly expanding sport, supported not only by tuition and the Annual Fund, but also by additional gifts as part of our special initiatives program. These special initiatives often provide short-term (1-3 years) financial support to new or quickly growing programs.

The crew program was bolstered last year by the generosity of nine families who lent their backing to our rowers and enabled the purchase of much-needed new equipment. The new boats and blades will benefit students for many seasons to come, and will be helpful in teaching those new to the sport as well as honing the skills of our more experienced rowers. Currently, we have a record number of rowers taking part, and with an equal gender balance.

Crew is our only three-season sport at ASL, and the boys and girls crews enjoyed a stellar year in 2021-22. Regular training sessions, both on and off the river (and often in the ASL pool!), paid dividends, with teams bringing home medals at several national competitions over the course of the year. We offer a huge thank you to those families for their commitment to the crew program. The dedication of our young crew members is inspirational, and it is gratifying to see the program go from strength to strength.



Thirty years of crew

The ASL crew program began in 1992, when a girls squad was started by Margaret Mellon P '94 '95 and her daughters, Gretchen '94 and Courtney '95. Initially sponsored by the Booster Club, as well as from fundraising, the team rowed out of Furnival Sculling Club in Hammersmith. A number of ASL teachers have lent their expertise to the teams over the decades, including Meg Bailey (ASL 1990-2014) and Judy Kisor (ASL 1994-2014). In 1995, the boys founded their own team, which was coached by Jim Guion (ASL 1995-98). Since that time, the program has flourished and generations of students have gone on to row for their universities and some have represented their countries at the international level.

Giving back to ASL: Reconnecting with a mutual understanding

In 1981, it never occurred to either Bob Fish '81 or Michelle (Cox) Fish '81 that 40 years later they would be married and traveling the world together in search of coffee farmers who are doing the right thing by their people, their communities and the planet. Bob and Michelle weren't close friends in high school and didn't keep in touch after graduation.

After college, Michelle was living in Cleveland, Ohio, working as a freelance writer, and singing with her blues band. Bob was in Lansing, Michigan, where he start BIGGBY COFFEE, a 100% franchised chain of coffee shops with 300 cafés open in 13 states, and 150 more to come. Fate brought them back together in 2006, in the form of a late-night email Michelle sent to the Class of 1981 Usenet Group. Bob answered, and much to their joint surprise, they fell in love and were married six months later.


"Our shared experience at ASL shaped who we are in a way that I don't think we fully understood at the time. When we met each other again, we had an instant, deep connection and mutual understanding. Total philanthropic support

The Annual Fund is the keystone of the ASL Foundation's fundraising efforts. It takes place every year and participation and support is encouraged from every member of the ASL community. In 2021-22 our community supported ASL Foundation's Annual Fund with 690 gifts ranging from £5 to £50,000+ and totalling more than £1.45M. Special initiatives are specific, short-term projects that facilitate program expansion or campus enhancement at ASL. Senior leadership and the Board of Trustees identify specific needs and seek restricted contributions from the ASL community that give promise of improved learning. This targeted fundraising is above and beyond revenue generated by the Annual Fund. In 2021-22, £2.1M was donated to support initiatives in computer science, the Eagle Scholar Fund, the Innovator-in-Residence program, security, and the crew program. Total philanthropic support is a combination of gifts to the Annual Fund and donations to special initiatives.
