We are so excited to announce the names of our **Commended Students and Semifinalists in the 2024 National Merit Scholarship Program**. Fairview is

incredibly proud to have **24 Commended Students and 22 Semifinalists!** Our 24 Commended Students placed among the top 50,000 students in the nation who took the 2022 PSAT/NMSQT last Fall. Those being named Commended Students have demonstrated outstanding potential for academic success. Our 22 Semifinalists are among the highest-scoring entrants in the state of Colorado and represent less than one percent of all U.S. high school seniors. 

 period or lunch period. 11th and 12th grade students can attend at any time

 with prior teacher permission to miss a class.
- Counselors are busy meeting with seniors right now about the college application process, reviewing college lists, giving feedback on essays, etc..
 Counselors have drop-in hours during Access time every **Thursday morning from 8:35 am 9:30 am** to answer any questions for students about the college application or anything else that comes up. There is also a counselor on

call during every lunch period on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday who is available to answer any counseling-related questions that students have. Schedule Changes for the first semester are almost done.

■ Students are able to drop classes with a WP/WF and change their Academic Placement level until 9/29/23. After 9/30/23 students will not be able to change levels of classes and any class that is dropped will be an F on their transcript.


