Exciting News: Secure Your Biliteracy Achievement with the STAMP Test at Fairview on October 26th!



Hello biliterate students!

Thanks for your patience as I worked to secure Fairview as a STAMP testing site this fall. Fairview has been secured! The STAMP will be held on **October 26th at 8:30 AM** in the Fairview library.

For those of you who don't know, the STAMP is a reading, writing, speaking and listening World Language test that you can take to show proficiency in a World Language as partial fulfillment of the Seal of Biliteracy requirements (you also have to show proficiency in English).

<u>Here</u> is more information about the **Seal of Biliteracy and the STAMP**. At the bottom of that linked info sheet, highlighted in yellow, are links to learn more about the STAMP, take sample tests, and pay. Paying for the STAMP acts as your registration for the STAMP. Please reach out to me if you would like help covering the test fee.

Important info you need to know:

- The test will be administered on Thursday, October 26th starting at 8:30 AM in the Fairview library.
- Bring a fully charged personal device and a charger.
- Bring a headset that has a microphone.
- You will be excused from any class time you miss.
