
WMS SUMMER CAMPS

A Week of Dance July 24-28

Students learned about, choreographed, and performed different types of dance each day. They learned about the history and elements of each type of dance. They worked to choreograph and perform a dance before the end of each day. For each type of dance, students demonstrated knowledge and understanding of the vocabulary incorporated daily. Types of dances included Contemporary, Modern, Hip Hop, Ballet, Tap, and Jazz. The class researched and provided input toward which dances were learned about each day.
