CROSS COUNTRY

Last Wednesday (9/27), the Livingston Cross Country program competed in the second Trans Valley League cluster meet in Ceres, at the River Bluff course. In the varsity boys race, the Pack racing team was able to hang on down the stretch to finish in 1st place. The varsity boys are 2-0 in TVL competition. With a team score of 57, the Pack finished ahead of their closest competition Ripon (63) and Escalon (64.) The Wolves were led by **Cristian Lucatero's** (pictured middle right) 3rd place finish. Other LHS finishers - **Anthony Aguilar** 5th, **Moises Cortes** 6th, **Heath Edwards** 21st, **Bradley Kaji** (pictured bottom right) 22nd, and rounding out the scoring was **Juan Avalos** who finished in 25th place in his first career 5k race. On the varsity girl's side, **Kiranjot Kaur** (pictured top right) finished 17th place and broke her previous best 5k time by 94 seconds. Freshman **Priseis Cintora**, 19th place, and **Alexa Gutierrez** 20th place were also able to finish in the top 20 in their first-ever 5k run. The future is bright for the girls' team. Both teams also ran well this past Saturday (9/30) at the Amanda Garcia Memorial Invitational at Atwater High School. The boys finished in 4th place while the girls finished in 5th place.
