Crown Point High School is a four year comprehensive public school located 45 miles southeast of Chicago, Illinois and 145 miles northwest of Indianapolis, Indiana. Serving the suburban communities of Crown Point, Winfield, Cedar Lake, and Lakes of Four Seasons, the school district's 65 square miles includes seven elementary schools (K-5), three parochial schools, two middle schools (6-8), and one high school (9-12). Crown Point High School (enrollment 2,878 students) and the nearby communities reflect the strong tradition of support for academic, cultural, and athletic achievement. Accredited by the North Central Association, Crown Point High School is the school of choice.

Graduation Requirements

As directed by the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE), students at CPHS may receive the Indiana Diploma with one of four distinctions: Core 40 with Academic Honors, Core 40 with Technical Honors, Core 40, or the General distinction. In addition, all students must meet the minimum standard on the ISTEP+ assessment or qualify for the Graduation Pathways. Minimal passing scores are set by the IDOE. 47.4% of graduates from the class of 2023 earned an Honors Diploma.
