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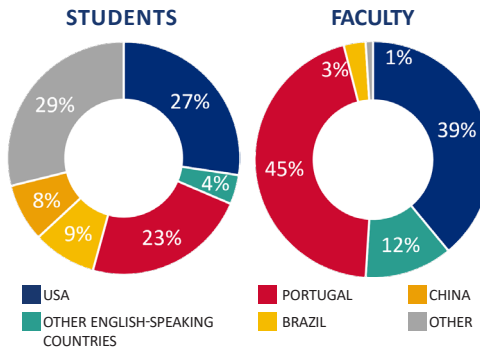


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FACILITIES: Library Media Center with over 40,000 print items, computers in all classrooms and wireless internet access throughout the campus, 1 computer per student in grades 1 through 5 in the classroom environment, one laptop checked out to each student in grades 6 through 12, fully equipped science laboratory classrooms, purpose-built art and music classrooms, state-of-the-art 450-seat theater, full-service cafeteria and snack bar, 1,400m² covered gymnasium, more than 10,000m² of exterior sports fields for basketball, soccer and other sports.

STUDENTS: Total of 740 at the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year representing 57 nationalities. Among these there are 201 American, 30 from English-speaking countries such as the U.K., Canada, and South Africa, and 168 Portuguese. **33% of our students have more than one nationality.**

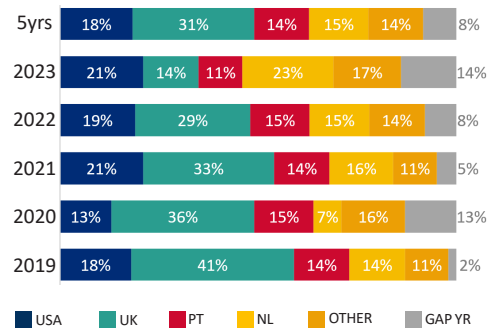


FACULTY: In the 2023-2024 school year, there are 100 full-time faculty members, including 39 U.S. citizens, 12 from other English speaking countries such as the U.K., Canada and Ireland, and 45 host-country nationals. The remaining are from other nationalities including Brazil and Romania. All teachers are either bilingual or native English speakers.

ENGLISH: English is the language of instruction. English support (*Foundations of English*) is provided based on individual student needs for no additional fee.

OTHER LANGUAGES: Portuguese Native Language and Foundations of Portuguese are offered for all grade levels plus French, Spanish and Chinese starting in Grade 7.

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS: In 2023 there were 57 graduating seniors: 12 students matriculated into American Universities, 13 into Dutch Universities, 8 into British Universities, 6 into Portuguese Universities, and 15 into universities elsewhere in the world. 8 students took a gap year.
