Year 10	A minimum of 3 pieces of online learning will be set per term, either using Educake or GCSE Pod to support consolidation of learning and reinforce knowledge from Year 9. Additional revision activities maybe set leading up to the PPEs at the end of Year 10.
Year 11	A minimum of 3 pieces of online learning will be set per term, either using Educake or GCSE Pod to support consolidation of learning and reinforce knowledge from Year 9 & 10. Additional revision activities maybe set leading up to the PPEs in November and March and for the final exams in May/June.
Post 16	Weekly reading in preparation for the upcoming lessons. On some occasions, this will be combined with activities to consolidate understanding. Students will be provided with a wider reading list that they should use to develop their understanding of topics more fully. A minimum of 4 exam questions will be completed per term. Research for the NEA coursework element will be set for year 12 in the summer term. Students will then complete the writing of their NEA in the summer term of year 12 and autumn term of year 13.
