

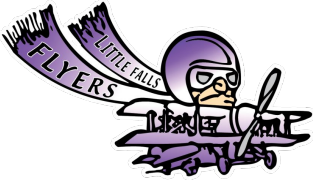

Using a book of your choice, write a new ending for your story. (Fictional Narrative)	Use a magnet from your refrigerator to test what is attracted to the magnet. Write down the objects that the magnet was attracted to.
Practice addition, subtraction, multiplication or division facts for 20 minutes.	Create and present a play for your family.	Write the steps on how to make a snowman. Make sure you include sequential transition words. (First, next, then, after, finally) (Informational Writing)	Make a map of your neighborhood. Make sure to create a key and label important landmarks.
Create a schedule of your day and create a graph displaying your data.	Read your favorite picture book to a parent, sibling, or pet! Practice reading fluently.	Using a book of your choice, respond to the following writing: Which character reminds you of yourself? What in the text supports your thoughts? (Responding to Literature)	Interview an adult from your house about what they did during their snow days when they were a child.
How many ways can you show 50 using equations? (Follow Order of Operations)	Create a timeline about your life including at least 8 important events in your life. Make sure that they are in the correct order.	Write a fictional story. Make sure you have a conflict, resolution and a beginning, middle and end. (Fictional Narrative)	Build the tallest structure you can with items around your house, (examples: legos, cards, pillows, play-doh or snow).
