Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes.	Count how many light switches you have in your home. Write that number down. Is it an even or odd number? Do the same with the number of door knobs you have.	Interview an adult about a snow day memory from their childhood; What did they do? When did this happen? Write 3 sentences.	Write a letter to your principal and tell him what you would do if you were in charge of the school.
Listen to a story; Retell the story to an adult; Remember key details from the beginning, middle and end.	Ask a grown-up if you can count, sort, and/or identify the coins in their pocket or around the house.	Grab a handful of snow. Put it in a bowl. Observe what happens when you bring it inside. Which takes up more space: snow or melted snow?	Write 3 sentences. Make sure they start with a capital letter and end with an ending mark.
*Practice reading Power Words/Red Words/Heart Words for at least ten minutes.	Choose 5 different 2-digit numbers. Write the number down then draw the number using base ten blocks.	Find a surface that is easy to slide across. Find a surface that is not easy to slide across. Why is one easier to slide on than the other?	Write 5 words to describe your favorite _____ (animal, food, toy, etc.).
Read out loud to your favorite stuffed animal or pet.	Look around your house and see if you can find any 3-D shapes. Write down what you find and what shape it is. <u>Example:</u> soup can=cylinder	How does your family, reduce, reuse, and recycle? Tell an adult about it.	Write a story about your day. Include at least three details.
Read a story. Then, write a sentence and illustrate your favorite part.	Write one addition and one subtraction word problem.	Identify the push and pull forces of 3 objects in your house. Share how push and pull forces make each object move with an adult.	Draw a picture and write a story to go with it. (Think about characters, setting, beginning, middle, and end.)
