

Articles of Agreement

For the purpose of this agreement, "Articulation" means the process to facilitate the transition of a student from one educational institution to another.

1. Walnut Hill College (WHC) agrees to grant appropriate college credit consistent with its current policies.
2. All students seeking Articulation Credits must complete all admissions requirements, be accepted to, and enroll in Walnut Hill College within six (6) months following successful completion of the Institutions program and remain enrolled at WHC for a period of no less than one term.
3. The Institution must provide a competency record for each student which certifies that the student earned a minimum grade of a "B" in each course to be articulated a minimum of 30 days prior to the start of WHC academic year.
4. The Institution must provide the attendance record for all courses for which articulation credit is being requested a minimum of 30 days prior to the start of WHC academic year.
5. Should the Institution's curriculum be altered in any way the Institution agrees to submit the updated changes to Walnut Hill College.
6. Articulation credits will be granted for approved articulated course(s) in the form of transfer credits (TR) and will appear on the student's college transcript. Neither letter nor numeric grades will be recorded on the student's transcript. The students Grade Point Average will not be impacted by Articulated Credits.

7. Articulation application forms must be signed by the director of the program or Guidance Counselor.
8. The maximum allowable articulation credits to be transferred cannot exceed ten (10) credits.
9. In order for articulated students to remain in 'full-time status' at WHC, courses may be added to the students program of study from other degree programs during terms in which articulated courses are completed.
10. Walnut Hill College reserves the right to schedule a student for any articulated course should the student not meet the competency requirements for that course.
11. A review of this Articulation Agreement and all its contents will be conducted a minimum of every two (2) years. Upon completion of the review by WHC all revisions will be communicated to the Institution and an updated Articulation Agreement will be signed by both parties.
12. The Articulation Agreement will begin with the academic year following the date of approval.
13. This Articulation Agreement is not retroactive and is not applicable to students enrolled in Walnut Hill College prior to the acceptance of this Articulation Agreement.





