CENTER GROVE, IN (November 19, 2013)—The Center Grove Community School Corporation Board of School Trustees toured four schools in the district Monday to learn how the buildings operate and hear the principals' plans for academic growth.

The board also observed the areas where changes are planned to improve safety, security, and learning environments during the upcoming \$42 million construction project. The construction project will create secure entries in all seven school buildings and address major educational effectiveness and capacity issues at North Grove Elementary, Center Grove Elementary and Center Grove High School.

"I enjoyed seeing the great work teachers and administrators are doing. I was very impressed by the students who led our tours. They were all very articulate," said Carol Tumey, school board secretary.

"The principals are excited and encouraged by what is happening in their schools," said Jack Russell, board president. "We want them to know we are here to support them in their missions."

Russell, Tumey, board members Adam Norman and Rob Richards, and Superintendent Rich Arkanoff met with teachers, students, and administrators at Center Grove Middle School North, North Grove, Pleasant Grove, and Sugar Grove Elementary Schools. Tours of the other four schools in the district, including the high schools' Alternative Academy, are planned for February.
