Bothell High School is a four-year public high school that graduated its first class in 1912. The district is within both King and Snohomish Counties. Bothell High School is accredited by the Association of Educational Service Districts (AESD). The 2023-24 school year started on September 6th and ends on June 24th, 2024

Note: In the middle of March 2020, the Northshore School District physically closed schools due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Second semester grades from that school year were achieved during remote learning. The grading scale was either A, B, or Incomplete depending on student engagement. For the 2020-21 virtual/hybrid school year and the 2021-22 in-person school year, A-D letter grades resumed, and F grades became NC.

EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS

- **Advanced Studies Programs:** A wide variety of challenging academic courses are offered to students through the College Board. These include Pre-AP and nineteen different Advanced Placement classes as well as nineteen College in the High School classes through University of Washington, Eastern Washington University, Edmonds, Everett and Cascadia Community colleges.
- **WANIC:** Washington Network for Innovative Careers is a consortium of seven school districts that provide over 30 classes of skill training in technical fields to its students where they may earn special certifications at BHS, which recognize them as specialists in areas of CCR.
- **Running Start:** This community college agreement is for high school students to earn high school and college credit concurrently. Students attend classes on the college campus.
- **Special Services:** Students with special needs are provided support through this program.
- **Pacific Northwest College Credit:** Students earn high school and community college credit concurrently in many occupational education classes provided they maintain a 'B' average in the class.

There were 433 students at Bothell High School who took 802 AP exams in May and June of 2023. Exams included subjects in English Language and Composition, Calculus A/B, Calculus B/C, English Literature & Composition, Computer Science A, AP Computer Science Principals, AP Music Theory, AP Biology, Chemistry, AP Psychology, Physics 1 & 2, Statistics, US Government/Politics, US History, World History, Chinese Language and Culture. Eighty-two percent achieved scores to earn college credit.



CURRICULUM

Bothell High School offers a broad range of curricular choices with emphasis on a strong academic program and a variety of quality vocational offerings. Bothell High School is on a semester system. A semester course equals 0.50 credit.
