



**Floyd County Schools
Gifted Education Services
High School Program Continuation Criteria
2023-2024**

The Floyd County Gifted Education Program requires that students adhere to the following adopted continuation criteria:

Maintain an overall average of **80** or above in gifted education including advanced content and cluster group classes, Executive Internship, Advanced Placement (AP) classes, Gifted Honors classes (HP), Gifted On-line.

*If the above criterion is not met, a team of teachers and/or administrators will meet with the student to formulate an improvement plan and to consider the following options:

1. A probationary period during which the student will not participate in Gifted Program classes.
2. A probationary period during which the student will participate in Gifted Program classes.

*Parents will be notified of all decisions and may request a conference with the gifted education teacher.

After the probationary period, the student's performance during the probationary period will be evaluated. At that time the following options will be considered:

1. Termination/Withdrawal from gifted program.
2. Continuation of probation.
3. Termination of probation status.
