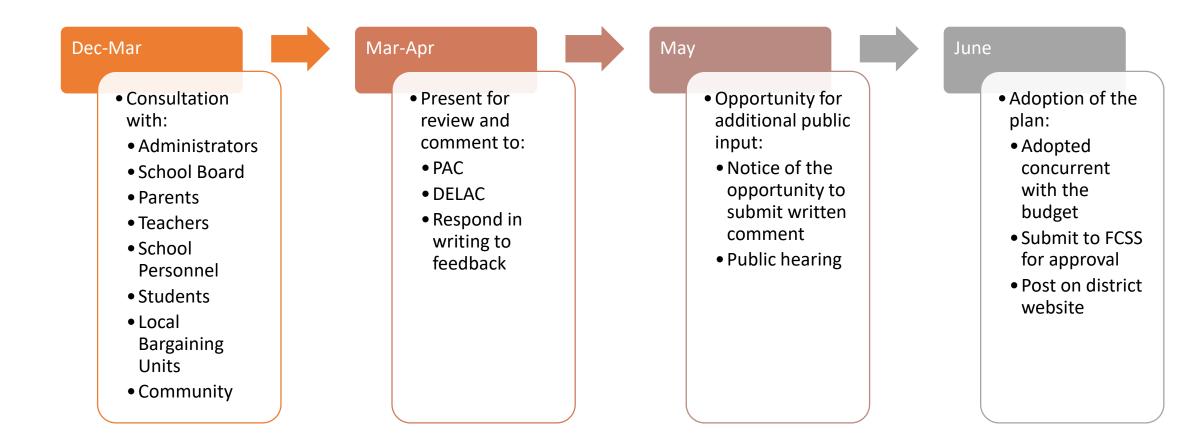
Ongoing Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) expenses
