## **Covid Response**

The class of 2024's freshman year—the 20-21 school year—began with hybrid learning. Most students attended two days a week in person and two days virtually. Some students opted to attend fully remote. After spring break, most students returned to in-person learning full time, while some remained fully remote. Students received semester grades, and graduation requirements remained unchanged throughout both school years. The 21-22 school year was all in person learning; there was no remote learning option.

## **Advanced Placement Courses**

Students must meet prerequisite requirements to be placed into an Honors or AP course. The prerequisites include grades in their current class and, for some, a PSAT score. Parents may sign a waiver for students who do not meet minimum requirements.

All AP Courses except for World History are only available to juniors or seniors unless otherwise noted.
