- Approval of Consent Agenda:
 - Welcome, reviewed agenda, and previous meeting minutes. Mrs. Kelly shared the updated budget report. Motion made by M. Yonts seconded by D. Kirkpatrick to approve.
- NEW BUSINESS

 - iii. 8th Grade Social and Transition Visits have been helpful and exciting for our 8th graders.
 - iv. Lindsey Wilson and Kristen Coulter both received educational awards. Mrs. Wilson was recognized by Campbellsville University for excellence in teaching and Kristen Coulter was recognized by CKEC.
 - b. **Public Comment-** Council members request that no transportation changes after a certain time be stated in the student handbook and enforced for the 2023-2024 school year with minimal phone calls to classrooms with daily transportation changes.

Planning for Student Achievement:

Comprehensive School Improvement Plan: iReady Spring Diagnostic Data

iReady spring diagnostic data for both reading and math was reviewed for all grade levels. All grade levels met or exceed annual typical growth for reading. School-wide data shows 125% growth in reading and 128% growth in math for the 22-23 school year.

Professional Development Hours- Update

Mrs. Kelly discussed with council changing the professional development hours to 2 district days, 1 school day, and 1 flex day now that we know what the plans would like for these days more specifically. District days will be used for SDI/coteach and data review. Our school day will be used to allow more learning around district wide and school initiatives. The flex day

can then be used for specific learning each teacher needs as related to their PGP. Motion was made by R. Whitaker and seconded by B. Price to approve.

Other Business:

Dress Code Policy Review

The policy was reviewed, and the following changes/additions were made: No Blankets, No holes above the knees. Changes will be made, and policy will be approved at June council meeting.

Morning Arrival Procedures

Morning arrival procedures were discussed to gain feedback. Main concern currently is the gym behavior and clean up. Council would like to see consistent expectations in gym, discussion of bleacher etiquette with students, and more specific procedures to see if this improves behavior and messes. Video modeling was suggested so all students and staff are hearing the same expectations.

Classroom space assignments were discussed only to allow council time to gain feedback. Options such as putting CARE into classroom settings and doubling up resource teachers was discussed. Utilizing a portion of the FRYSC office (currently clothes closet) was also discussed.
