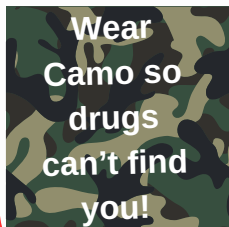

Where to PARK at SFISD Campuses??

- High School: Staff Parking lot by the Tennis Courts, handicap is available in the front of school or by auditorium
- Junior High School: Parking is located in the parking lot by HEB or the parking lot by the gym.
- Barnett: Front parking lot, enter front parking lot by turning at light on G1/2. Come to the front office and check in.
