- 1. Create a new file folder, make this your destination for all of your scholarships.
- 2. Download the scholarship file, save the scholarship in the folder you have just created. You will be accessing and using the newly saved scholarship.
- 3. Open the scholarship that has been saved to your new folder. If you fill in the application directly after opening it from the website nothing that you type in will be saved. You have to: Open/Download/Save/Re-open.

It is recommended that you use Google Docs to write your essays and create your activity lists; then copy/paste into your application.

The recipient:

- 1. Shall have been enrolled in the Amity Schools for a minimum of two years at the time of submitting the application form.
- 2. Shall submit a transcript with a cumulative 2.50 GPA or higher.
- 3. Shall complete the attached scholarship application form, submitting it to the Amity High School ASPIRE Coordinator.
- 4. Shall submit one letter of recommendation from an Amity School District employee.
- 5. Shall enroll in a Community College or a 4-year College/University.

Amount of Scholarship:

One \$750 scholarship shall be awarded when an appropriate candidate makes application. Payment will be made to the respective College/University business office on behalf of the recipient after a registration receipt is received at the Amity School District Office.

Selection Committee:

The selection committee shall be consistent with the donor's request through the Amity School District Foundation.
