### Phonemic Awareness

Explicit instruction in identifying and manipulating individual speech sounds in spoken language.

### Phonics

Direct instruction in the relationship between sounds and written letters that is sequential, systematic, and explicit.

**Includes:**  
decoding  
morphology  
high frequency words

### Fluency

Monitored daily practice with repeated readings to build accuracy, automaticity, and appropriate expression.

### Vocabulary

Explicitly teaching word meanings to build background knowledge across content areas.

The ultimate goal of reading, which combines word recognition and language comprehension to make meaning with automaticity.
