- SAT and ACT information
 - **(NOT REQUIRED)**
 - If reported-- ONLY looked at for placement
- EOP DEADLINES - vary for campus

- **GPA: Minimum GPA 2.5**
- **GPA and Supplemental Factors**
- **No SAT and ACT for admissions * if reported will only be used only for placement**
- **Deadline: November 30th (a few CSUs have extended the deadline-check specific schools)**

- **California State ID can be found on the bottom left side of your transcript.**

Statewide Student ID

A Statewide Student ID (SSID) is a unique, 10-digit number assigned to you if you attended a public California K - 12 school. The number is located on your California high school transcript. If you did not attend a public high school in California, you may leave the SSID blank.





Do NOT enter your Social Security Number into this field.

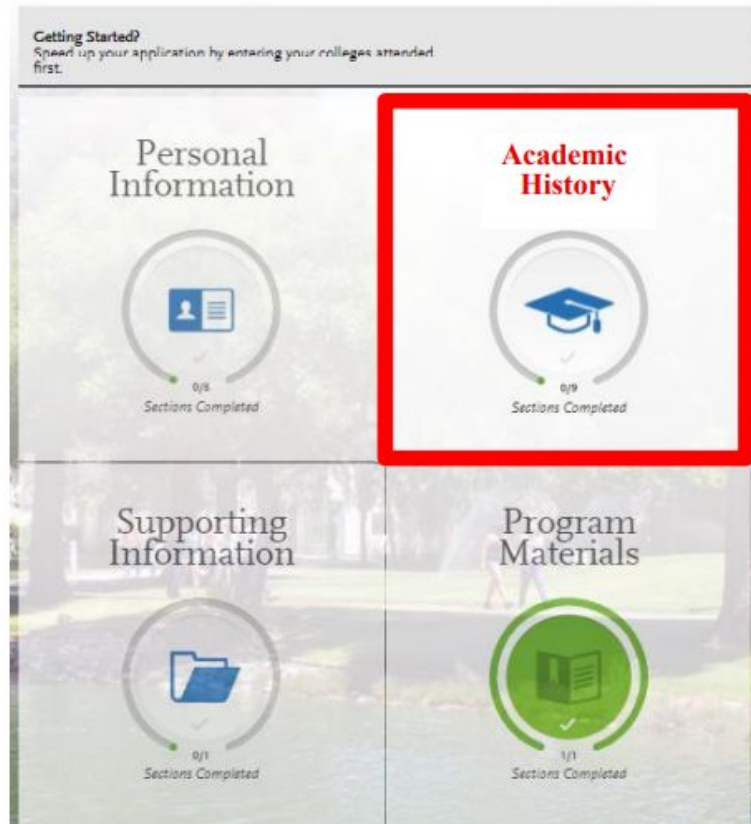

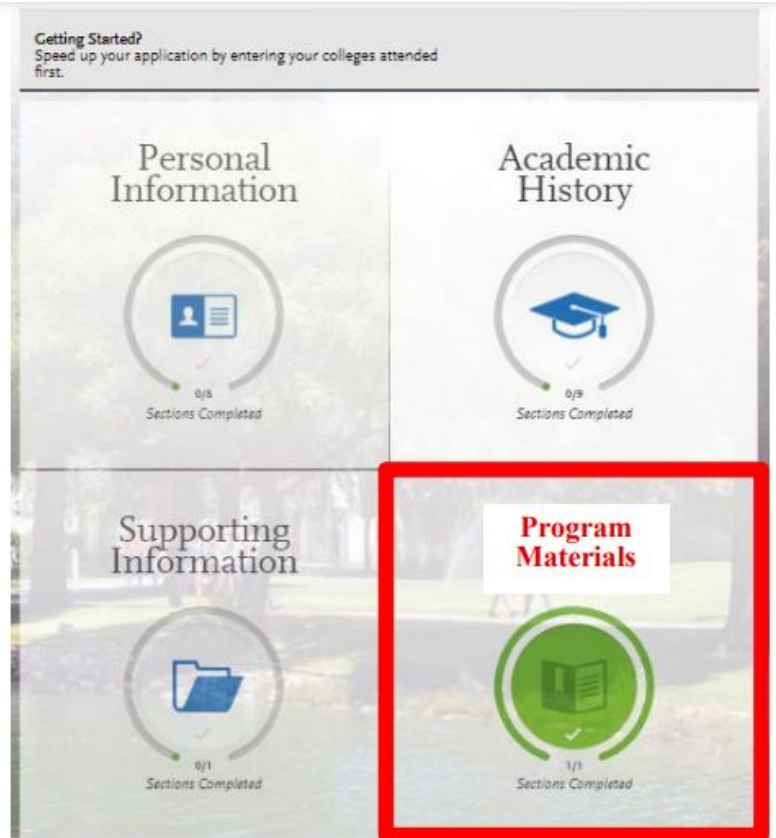
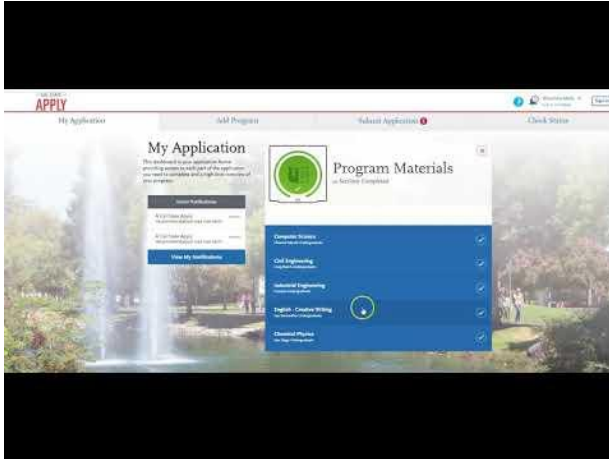
